Evaluation of 3rd BINA workshop:

We can be short: we enjoyed it a lot!

Publication of proceedings 3rd BINA workshop:

The different sections should be made visible in the introduction paper of the proceedings. SJ suggests to include the titles of the presentation(s) of participants in the table with the overview of the participants (Table 2). However, this would make the table very large. Alternatively, we could:

- add a column with an "ID nr" for the talks listed Tables 4 and 5 (e.g. 'S01-IT1' for the talk of Nissim Kaneka),
- add a table with the overview of the poster presentation, also including a column with an "ID nr" for the posters (e.g. 'S02-P05' for the poster of PDC),
- add an extra column in Table 2 to include the "ID nr" of the presentation(s) for which the participant is PI (or co-author, but that will require a lot more work)

As the number of papers submitted for the different sessions of the 3rd BINA workshop varies a lot (from 0 to 20) and we need to avoid conflicts of interest (the guest editor should not be a co-author of papers attributed to him/her), we should redistribute the papers amongst all the guest editors (by taking into account their expertise as much as possible) in an attempt to balance the workload for everybody.

No proceedings papers from the solar physics sessions have been submitted (it is not clear why), but the chairpersons of these sessions will be invited to be a co-author on the introduction paper as a token of our appreciation for their efforts.
